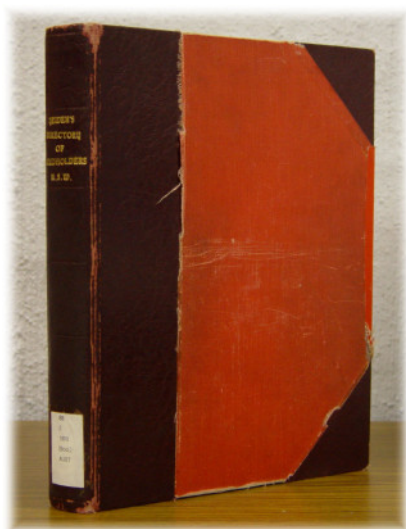

## ... Publishers' Note ...

---

**I**N issuing this, the first broad attempt at publishing a complete directory of the landowners of New South Wales, the greatest care has been taken to obtain the fullest information of the production of each district in the colony, with the live stock, &c., as well as to secure unerring accuracy in detailing the particular uses to which each landholder puts his property. We show the extent of the district by giving the number of acres alienated, and crown lands occupied; we show the extent to which each district is cultivated, and the main crops grown; also the use to which the other land is put by the number and kind of stock enumerated. There must, however, necessarily be some slight changes, some removals made, and some new settlers coming in between the receipt of our information and the publication of a work of this magnitude. So, too, with the acreage under crops, and the numbers of live stock, &c., hence we publish the particulars obtainable up to 1899, and which are accurate enough to-day for all practical purposes, that is to say, the statistics give the key to the agricultural, pastoral, and dairying strength of a district during the past season. Allowance has to be made for the season, whether in wheat growing centres, or dairying and grazing districts; some have been good and others bad—some normal, and others abnormal; allowance has also to be made for the sudden expansion in export of live stock, as with horses for South Africa, and the rushing of sheep and cattle to market through drought.

All things considered, we offer the directory to the public in the fullest confidence of both its accuracy and usefulness.

### ALBURY DISTRICT.

**W**ITH the town of Albury, situated on the Murray, and connecting the New South Wales and Victorian Railway Systems, as its commercial centre, we have of the most important in the southern portion of the Colony. It is embraced in the counties of DENISON, LIME, GOULBURN and SELWYN. THE SUBDIVISIONS ARE:—ALBURY, BOWNA, COROWA, CULCAIRN, DAYSDALE, GERMANTON, HOWLONG, JINDERA, MULWALA, TOOMA, TUMBERUMBA, WALBUNDRIE and WALLA WALLA. AREAS ALIENATED AND CULTIVATED—In this district there were 2,052,586 acres alienated in 1899, and 658,109 acres of Crown Lands occupied, total number of holdings of over one acre being 1,424. Under cultivation there are 245,582 acres as follows:—Wheat for grain, 210,914 acres; for hay, 20,468 acres; Barley for grain, 133 acres; for hay, 28 acres; Oats for grain, 1,896 acres; for hay, 6,366 acres; Lucerne, 110 acres; Tobacco, 7 acres; Potatoes, 221 acres; Grape Vines, 1,852 acres; Oranges, 4 acres; other fruit orchards, 455 acres; all other crops, 3,128 acres. LIVE STOCK—In this district there are also 16,325 horses, 6,330 milch cows, 38,575 ordinary cattle, 1,126,271 sheep, and 2,531 swine. WHEAT YIELD—This district yielded 1,860,385 bushels of wheat in 1898-99 on an area of 231,382 acres. In 1899-1900 it is estimated the yield will average 9.4 bushels on 240,808 acres, or a total of 2,050,034 bushels. Albury is 534 feet above sea level, 388 miles from Sydney, and 190 miles from Melbourne.

# Getting around this CD

## Navigating Archive CD Books CDs

---

All Archive CD Books products can be navigated easily using the handy bookmarks on each CD. The table of contents in most original books, and the original book index where it exists, can provide additional ways of finding the information required.

## Searching Text on Archive CD Books Australia CDs

---

Optical Character Recognition (OCR) technology has been developing over the years as a useful mechanism to convert images (as Archive CD Books pages are) into text which can be searched. The quality of the OCR can still vary, and hence the searchability can vary. Around 95% or 99% of the words in books with good type are searchable—or even higher with very good type.

*OCR is now a wonderful searching aid in many instances  
but there is still no substitute for reading the book!*

## Different Versions of Adobe Acrobat Reader

---

Adobe Acrobat Reader 4 or later should be used. Adobe Reader 6 (as it is now named) in fact has considerably better searching options and is recommended.

- **Acrobat Reader v4** has both a “Find” and a “Search” tool. Those tools are two \*totally\* different things. Our CDs (that are searchable) work with the \*FIND\* tool
- **Acrobat Reader v5** has only a “Find” tool (not a “search” tool). Our CDs (that are searchable) work with the \*FIND\* tool.
- **Adobe Reader v6** has only a “Search” tool (not a tool labelled “Find”). HOWEVER — what is called “Search” is the same as the tool that used to be called “Find” Our CDs (that are searchable) work with the \*SEARCH\* tool

## Tips For Searching and Getting More From the CD Books

---

- update to Adobe Reader 6 for more versatile searching options, including the ability to bring up a list of all instances of the word you are searching for — across multiple files on a single CD in a single search request.
- enter the MINIMUM number of characters needed to bring up the search results required.
- use Adobe Reader 6 to do some trial searches to try to identify the characters that may be misread. These can show up in the extra text in the search results list (Adobe 6 only). A few minutes trial will help you to avoid using characters that are more prone to being misread, e.g. try entering “rederi” if you want “Frederick”, but find that the letters “F” “c” and “k” are sometimes misread.
- use the “Match whole word” option to eliminate unnecessary items in your results list, e.g. to eliminate all the blacksmiths and tinsmiths etc when you only want the name Smith.
- use the “Match case” option to eliminate all the occupations “smith” if you only want the name “Smith”.
- don’t just search for names. Search the book for other names, places and subjects of interest:
  - › look for others of the same name
  - › look for others who lived in the same place or street
  - › who was the postmaster or police officer in the town?
  - › how often and at what time did the coach arrive in town?
  - › what churches were there and what time were services held?
  - › what other activities were there in the community?
  - › look for others who had the same occupation or other interests
- all of this and more may be available in a seemingly mundane book such as a directory. You can learn much of the background of life at the time, even if your ancestor is not listed there.
- Many CDs have only one file, but some have the book content spread over several files. Adobe Reader normally searches in the file that is open at the time. If you wish to search ALL files at once choose the “All PDF documents in” option and select the CD drive or directory the files are in—Adobe Reader 6 only.
